Needs, Resources & Gaps, Planning for the Future

<u>Livable New York</u> is a New York State initiative meant to help foster livable communities across the State. The <u>Livable New York: Resource Manual | Office for the Aging (ny.gov)</u> is a community resource manual for future-based, inclusive planning; livable communities; aging-in-place, and sustainable neighborhoods.

<u>GetSetUp</u> – <u>New York State Office for the Aging · GetSetUp</u> brings 900 courses and classes into the homes of older adults and provides an economic opportunity for older adults to teach classes on the platform and supplement their income by getting paid for their skill. Free for anyone over 50.

<u>Pets Together - Pets Together - Virtual Video Chats with Pets!</u> combats isolation by connecting individuals to volunteers using the power of pet therapy to combat loneliness and isolation. Free.

<u>VivaLynx - www.vivalynx.com</u> is a fee for service, mobile app that enables clients, caregivers and their professional team to manage care in the home.

Everhome www.everhomecareadvisors.com is a fee for service organization offering Aging Life Care Coordinators to assist with managing care options, coping with health and age-related changes, exploring insurance entitlements, navigating the legal, insurance and financial aspects of caregiving, finding local caregiving resources, and using automation as a tool to help organize a plan of care.

<u>New York Connects</u> <u>www.nyconnects.ny.gov</u> can help link you to long term services and supports, such as home care, transportation and meals.

Transportation

<u>CareLinks - Care Links | CAPTAIN CHS (captaincares.org)</u> provide supportive services, such as transportation, at no cost to persons 60+ in the towns of Ballston (including Burnt Hills), Charlton, Clifton Park, Halfmoon, Malta, the village of Ballston Spa, and the city of Mechanicville.

<u>CDTA Flex – Flex | www.cdta.org</u> is a fee for service, on-demand system that provides connections to: Mechanicville, Halfmoon, and Clifton Park.

<u>GoGoGrandparent</u> - <u>https://get.gogograndparent.com</u> provides on-demand services such as rides, meals, groceries and prescription delivery on a fee for service basis.

<u>Senior Express Clifton Park</u> - <u>Senior Transportation (cliftonpark.org)</u> transports individuals 50 years and older who are residents of the Town of Clifton Park to medical appointments as requested to the following areas: Albany, Schenectady, Troy, Ballston Spa, Saratoga, Mechanicville and Latham.

<u>Senior Express Halfmoon</u> - <u>Senior Express | Halfmoon NY (townofhalfmoon-ny.gov)</u> transports seniors 55 years of age living in the town of Halfmoon to doctor appointments, hair appointments, post office, grocery shopping and senior center activities.

<u>Waterford Medical Transport Van Seniors - Town of Waterford, NY</u> operates Monday thru Thursday. For more information on this service please call 518-527-4589.

<u>Wellness Express</u> - <u>Wellness Express Transportation | CAPTAIN CHS (captaincares.org)</u> provides transportation for residents to medical appointments to residents 60+ in the towns of Ballston, Charlton, Galway, Malta, Milton, Providence, and the Village of Ballston Spa.

Caregivers

<u>Arch Angels</u> Caregiver Intensity Index. - https://archangelscii.me/3EwYLBz helps caregivers identify with and feel honored in their role, gives them an Intensity Score, and navigates them to free resources for their unique needs.

<u>ALZConnected</u> - <u>Home - ALZConnected</u> is a free online community designed for people living with dementia and those who care for them. Members can post questions about dementia-related issues, offer support, and create public and private groups around specific topics.

Caregiver-Directed Respite Voucher Program https://www.nyscrc.org/respite-voucher-program
Caregivers can apply for a respite voucher in the amount of \$600 and choose the provider, which can be family members or friends. For Kinship families, the voucher can pay for programs/classes for the kids

- Caregiver is considered the employer and must act as such (hiring, firing training, etc.)
- NYSCRC, managed by Lifespan acts only as a Fiduciary

LifePath – <u>LifePath</u> provides the highest quality of services to people needing specialized supports through the blending of professional knowledge, arts and skills in an environment of unconditional respect and dignity.

<u>Trualta</u> - NYSOFA, AgingNY and Trualta Provide Free Web-Based Support Platform for All Family <u>Caregivers in NYS | Office for the Aging</u> is evidence-based training and support platform for all caregivers in NYS. This is free for anyone who provides care to a loved one.
