Care Links was first established with assistance from the Robert Wood Johnson Foundation to "link those in need with those who care," thereby enabling persons in need who are 60 and older to continue to live independently in their own homes for as long as possible. The program arose from a growing concern about the number of older residents and their caregiving family members seeking respite and other support needed to remain in the community. Over the years, it fell under the umbrella of the **Burnt Hills-Ballston Lake Community** Human Services Corporation. Today. it's a proud part of CAPTAIN Community Human Services.

Care Links serves the towns of Ballston (including Burnt Hills), Charlton, Clifton Park, Halfmoon, Malta, and the city of Mechanicville. Care Links receives funding from these towns and the Saratoga County Office for the Aging.
