### **Food Programs**

Our emergency food and hygiene pantry, **Karyl's Kupboard**, provides Saratoga County residents with nutritious food and hygiene products. Located in our Clifton Park office, the pantry is completely free and is staffed by volunteers. In addition to the pantry, we operate the **Free Summer Meals** and weekend backpack program to provide nutrition for Saratoga County's school-age children. During the holidays, we offer free **Thanksgiving baskets** to our community's families in need.

## **Homeless Youth**

Our Street Outreach Project assists youth who are, or may be at risk of becoming, homeless. We meet the youth where they are - providing case management and referral services. ## **Youth Shelter**

Certified by the NYS Office of Children & Family Services, our Runaway & Homeless Youth Shelter is a safe haven for 13-17 year-olds who are homeless, runaways, exploited, or in danger of becoming homeless. The Shelter offers a safe place of refuge to youth in crisis, with adults they can trust, and case management services to address individual challenges and connect the youth with a safe and stable home.

### **Family Assistance**

Our Family Assistance Program provides one-time, emergency financial assistance for individuals and families experiencing a hardship or crisis that could leave them without heat, shelter, or other essential needs. In addition, our Solutions to End Homelessness Program (STEHP) is a NYS-funded program to help individuals and families facing a housing crisis. Finally, Bike Works provides bicycles to residents throughout Saratoga County for recreation, transportation, and as a means of promoting a healthy lifestyle.

To qualify for some of these programs, individuals or families must receive some form of public assistance, such as SNAP. HEAP. Medicaid. Medicare. or free or reduced school lunches.

#### **Senior Services**

**Care Links** helps to keep people living independently in their homes as long as possible through friendly visiting, respite assistance, shopping, errands, transportation, and more. These services are available at no cost to persons 60+ in Southern Saratoga County. In addition to Care Links, our **Wellness Express** van provides free transportation for residents 60+ to medical appointments in the towns of Ballston, Charlton, Galway, Malta, Milton, and the Village of Ballston Spa. Both programs receive funding from the Saratoga County Office for the Aging.

## Youth Development

Our **Getting** Ahead program is a 12-16 week group workshop to help people stabilize their situations and build resources to improve their lives. The program supports families on their journey to self-sufficiency.

Our Family Support Program provides advocacy, information and referral, proactive intervention services, and education for families with children who have social. developmental, and/or emotional challenges. We also provide respite for families, as well as youth and adult skill-building services. The program empowers parents to access, advocate, and navigate the complex systems of support and connects with other families facing similar challenges.
