

FAMILY ASSISTANCE

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Our Family Assistance Program provides one-time, emergency financial assistance for individuals and families experiencing a hardship or crisis that could leave them without heat, shelter, or other essential needs.

Emergency rental or utility assistance is available to those residents of Saratoga County who have received a notice of eviction, are at imminent risk of losing their housing, are literally homeless, or are facing a utility shutoff.

Our Family Assistance Program also provides advocacy to help you access other community services that you may qualify for.

KARYL'S KUPBOARD

CAPTAIN CHS operates an Emergency Food and Hygiene Pantry known as "Karyl's Kupboard."

Located at CAPTAIN CHS's Clifton Park office (5 Municipal Plaza, Suite 3), the pantry is open to any member of Saratoga County who is in need of food, and it may be utilized once every 30 days. No appointments are necessary, and there is a simple application.

The pantry is open Monday, Tuesday, and Thursday from 10am - 3pm.
